Papers are invited in the areas of accounting, finance, and economics (including, but not limited to, the topics of Auditing, Financial Accounting & Reporting, International Accounting, Corporate Governance, and Ethics). Submissions should be received by **Monday, July 10, 2017**. All manuscripts are subject to a blind review process. Email notification of the outcome of each submission will be sent to the corresponding author or authors in early August.

Each paper submission should include a title page listing the corresponding author's name and email address. All papers must be in Word or PDF format and emailed to: ccrg@fullerton.edu.

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The Haskell & White Corporate Reporting & Governance Conference is intended to provide opportunities for academics to engage with experienced researchers and network with the practicing community. We especially encourage current and recently graduated PhDs to submit papers.

The CCRG will host the academic conference on September 14, 2017 followed by the 16th Annual SEC "Hot Topics" Conference on September 15, 2017. The SEC Conference is attended by over 500 professionals from Southern California. Academics are invited to both events at the Irvine Marriott Hotel in Irvine, California.
